that the state continues to attract industrial investment from the private sector.

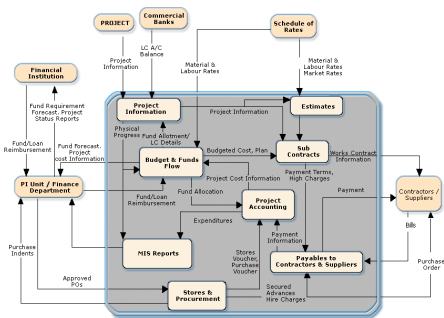
- Maintain a lean organization that empowers its employees with information and decision making.

Solutions from Microsoft and our partner allows more time to be spent on your core mission by streamlining government administration functions.



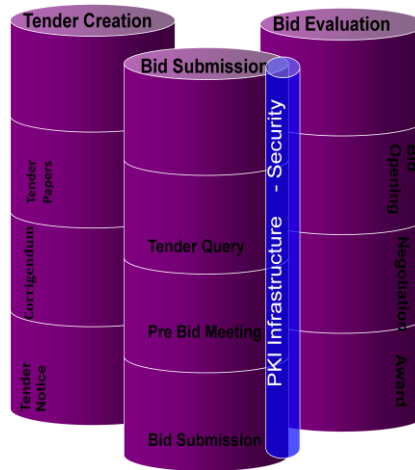
### Benefits

#### Easier Data Management

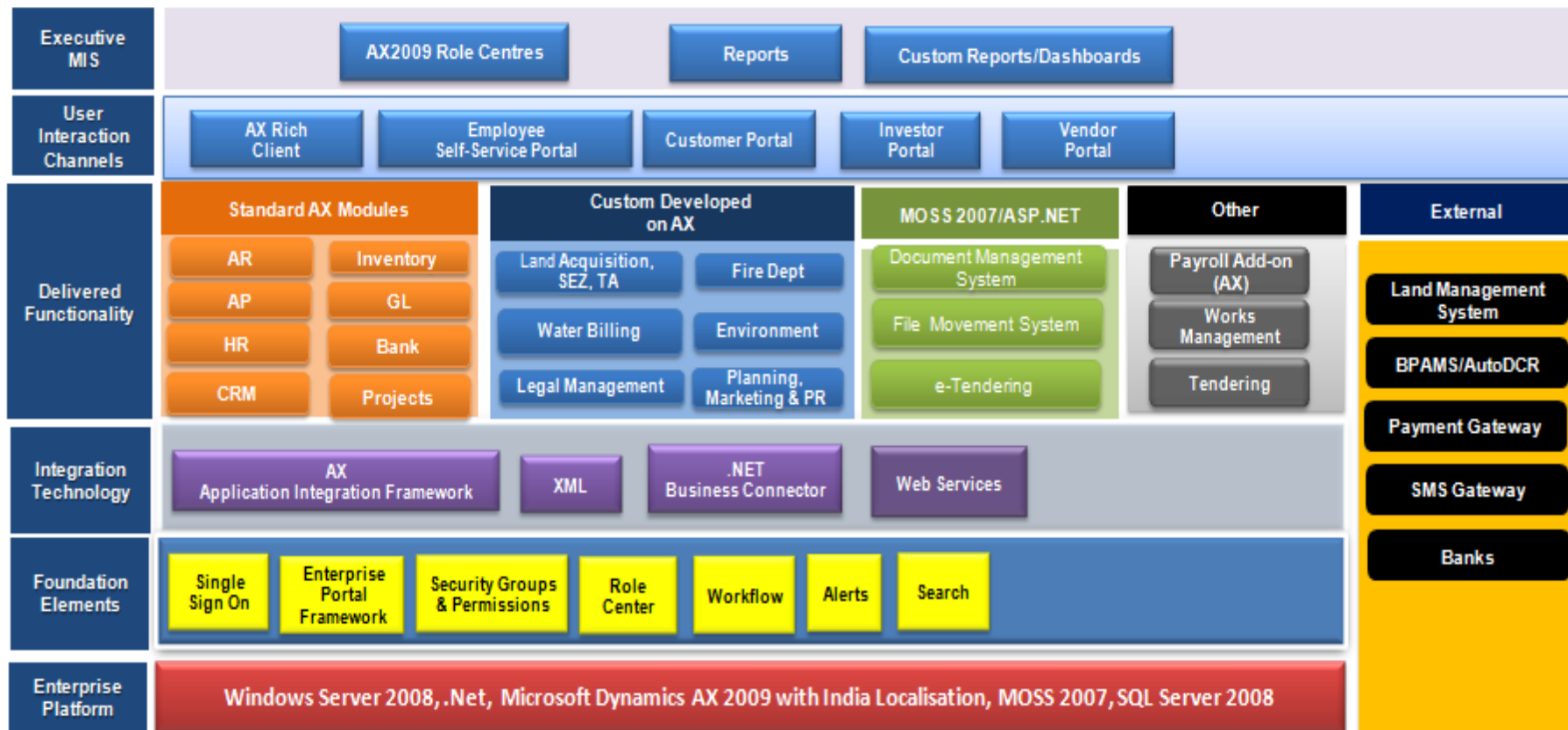
Earlier, MIDC had several stand-alone applications built on different generations, platforms and operating in silos. Data management was a key challenge.



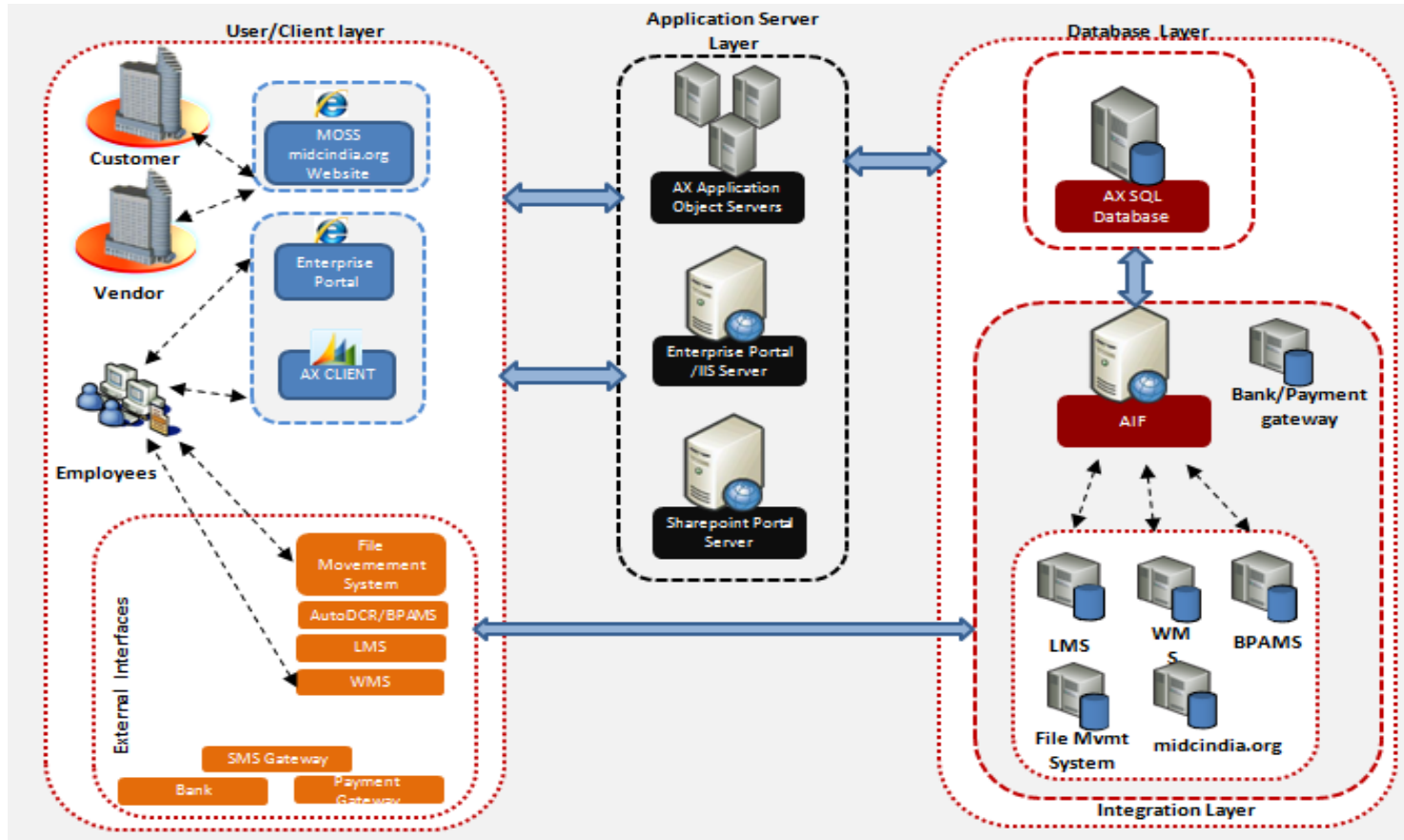
### Conclusion
